

# Fall Fiber Festival & Montpelier Sheep Dog Trials October 2 & 3, 2010

## SKEIN, GARMENT, AND FIBER ARTS COMPETITION ENTRY FORM

### Rules of Competition:

1. Only one entry per class will be accepted from each entrant. Entry will be made of predominately (80%) natural fibers, with up to 20% new fibers derived from natural sources, i.e. soy silk, bamboo, etc. Novelty skeins and projects using sock yarn may include up to 20% manmade fibers". *Festival vendors are limited to no more than 2 entries, total – this is a change.*
2. Each article must be made by the entrant alone.
3. Work must have been completed in the year since the 2009 FALL FIBER FESTIVAL.
4. There is a fee of \$2.00 per skein or article.
5. Payment must accompany entry form. Make check payable to: Fall Fiber Festival of Virginia, Inc.
6. **ENTRIES AND FORMS MUST BE RECEIVED BY SEPTEMBER 18, 2010.** They can be mailed to the below address:

7. Your entry must be received NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 18, 2010. Entries arriving after that time will not be accepted.
8. Judging will take place the week prior to the Festival. All entries will be on display under supervision during the Festival. No entries will be released until Sunday, October 3, between 4:00-5:00 p.m.
9. If you need to have your entry returned by mail or UPS, you must include postage, appropriate self addressed packaging and insurance with your entry form. Unclaimed items will become the property of the Fall Fiber Festival of Virginia, Inc.
10. The Festival Committee will make every effort to display and care for items entered, but assumes no responsibility for damage or loss.
11. Ribbons will be awarded for each class. A rosette will be awarded to the winner of each Division. A rosette will be awarded for the Best in Show. **First and second place in each class will also be awarded a prize from our Fall Fiber vendors!** Judges reserve the right to withhold awarding ribbons/prizes when entries do not warrant recognition.
